Workshop

English—reading

- Asking questions to improve understanding
- Drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence.

English—writing

- Using modal verbs or adverbs to indicate degrees of possibility
- Using the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships of time and cause

Post workshop lesson plans

English—writing—composition

- Plan their writing by identifying the audience for and purpose of the writing, selecting the appropriate form and using other similar writing as models for their own
- Using a wide range of devices to build cohesion within and across paragraphs
